We have heard Shri Balwant Sharma, learned proxy
counsel for applicant and Shri R.N.Singh, learned proxy

2. It is found that the appeal filed by the
applicant is yet to be decided. In paras 4.23 & 4.24 of
the reply, the respondents have indicated that the appeal
has been referred to the UPSC for their advice on behalf
of the competent appellate authority. The case had been
