### **O R D E R (ORAL)**

#### **Justice L. Narasimha Reddy:**

The applicants are working as Superintendent in the Govt. of NCT of Delhi, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent herein. It is stated that they acquired eligibility to be considered for promotion to the post of Senior Superintendent on completion of eight years of service, and despite that, the respondents are not taking any steps. It is also stated that there are as many as eight vacancies available now.

2. We heard Sri Yogesh Sharma, learned counsel for applicants and Ms. Esha Mazumdar, learned counsel for respondents, at the stage of admission.



3. The applicants state that they became eligible to be considered for promotion in the year 2018 itself on completion of eight years of service in the present post. That fact, however, by itself, does not confer the right upon them. At the same time, the respondents are under obligation to take steps for promotion to the post in case the vacancies exit and qualified persons are available. The stagnation in the feeder category would have its own adverse impact with the administration.

4. We, therefore, dispose of the O.A. directing the respondents to take necessary steps for promotion to the post of Senior Superintendent, within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. M.As. shall stand disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
