O R D E R (ORAL)

Shri Justice Ashok Agarwal:-

Applicant had been promoted to the post of Chief Booking Supervisor in the pay scale of Rs.2000-3200 and was posted at Sonapat by an order passed on 8.11.1996. Applicant did not accept the order of promotion as he did not desire to go on his posting to Sonapat. Aforesaid order of promotion was, therefore, not given effect to. Applicant, in our view cannot insist on the aforesaid order of promotion as also on his posting at Delhi.

2. Present OA which has been filed after applicant has retired on superannuation claiming

benefits of the aforesaid promotion, in our view, is devoid of merit. The same is accordingly summarily rejected.
