We have heard, Shri M.A.Rehman, learned counsel for the petitioner. He has submitted that the respondents have done nothing by way of implementation of the Tribunal's order dated 18.3.2002 in OA 1852/2001. Hence this CP.

2. We have seen the Tribunal's order dated 18.3.2002. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the post in question has neither been filled by any candidate on the basis of promotion or by <sup>12</sup>

transfer on deputation. His grievance mainly is that the respondents have not filled up the post by promotion or <sup>by</sup> <sup>rs</sup> 2 transfer on deputation, as the case may be.

3. Having regard to the relevant rules which have been referred to in the Tribunal's order dated 18.3.2003 and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, we are unable to agree with him that any prima-facie case has been made out to warrant issuance of notice in CP 87/2003. In the circumstances of the case, CP 87/2003 is dismissed.
