Heard both the sides in CP alleging non-compliance of Tribunal's order dated 12.11.2001 in OA-1936/2001.

- 2. By that order, respondents had been directed to convene a review DPC to reconsider the applicant's case for promotion to the SAG after ignoring certain ACRs, within 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
- 3. Respondents' counsel informs us that review DPC has been held on 15.4.2002 in which applicant's case has been reconsidered, and a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken very shortly.



- 4. No doubt, the aforesaid DPC was not held within the time allowed, but the delay, if any, is not great and is not sufficient reason to continue with these contempt proceedings.
- 5. Applicant states that in the meantime with a view to harass him he has been transferred, but if he has any grievance with regard to the same, he is at liberty to challenge the transfer order separately in accordance with law if so advised because that does not form a part of the Tribunal's direction dated 12.11.2001.
- 4. Giving leave to applicant as aforesaid, the CP is dropped. Notices discharged.
