Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.


2. The matter relates to promotion from Technical Officer 'A' to Technical Officer 'B' in the respondents organisation. It is grievance of the applicant that the Assessment Committee was not properly constituted. It is stated that the applicant was not promoted even after the review made by the Assessment Committee. Several grounds have been taken in the O.A.

Since no order was passed by the Assessment Committee either rejecting the promotion of the applicant or promoting the others, we direct the applicant to make a representation to respondent 2 within 10 days from today and such representation, respondent no.2, is directed to dispose of by a reasoned order, within two weeks thereafter. It is open to the applicant to move this court again after he receives such order and he is aggrieved by the same.

4. The O.A. is dismissed with the above observations, at the admission stage.
