
RA 259/2000 has been filed by Respondent 4, Shri Ramesh Chander in OA 966/1999 praying for review of the order dated 3.8.2000 passed by the Tribunal.

2. We have carefully perused the Review Application and are unable to agree with the submissions made by the review applicant that the order dated 3.8.2000 should be reviewed on the grounds taken by him. The order dated

3.8.2000 has been passed after hearing the counsel for the parties, including Shri B. Lall, learned counsel for Respondent 4, and taking into account the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Ajit Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.** (JT 1999(7) SC 153). As the review applicant has not shown that there is any error apparent on the face of the records or any other sufficient reasons, as provided under Order 47 Rule 1 CPC, read with Section 22(3)(f) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, we find no good grounds to allow the Review Application. In the circumstances, RA 259/2000 is rejected.
