Hon'ble Mr. N.V. Krishnan:-


The OA-2162/94 was dismissed at the admission stage by the order dated 1.12.94. The applicant has sought a review of that order. We have seen the RA and are satisfied that it can be disposed of by circulation. We proceed to do so.


2. The applicant was aggrieved by the fact that he was not considered for deputation for training abroad. That grievance of his was considered in detail and we found from the record that the respondents had sufficient reasons ^{to} ~~to~~ not to send him on deputation abroad for training. Hence the OA was dismissed.

3. In the application for review the applicant has again traversed the same grounds as in the O.A. He has not pointed out to any specific errors apparent on the face of record, requiring a review.
