
ORDER 'ORAL'

Shri G.N. Pant, the applicant, has filed this application for direction to the respondents to consider him for appointment to the post of Director General, National Museum, stating that he is eligible for appointment to the post, and also for a declaration that the respondent No.4 was not eligible for being considered for appointment to the post as he had crossed the maximum age limit of 56 years. Pursuant to an interim order issued in this case, the applicant was also considered and the result was kept in a sealed cover. At our request, the counsel for the third respondent made available for our perusal the records of the Selection Committee including what was kept in the sealed cover. We have perused the materials and it was found that though the applicant as also the fourth respondent were considered, respondent No.3 found the fourth respondent suitable for the post. Taking note of this situation, the learned counsel for the applicant wishes to withdraw this application without any costs. The move is not opposed by the counsels on the other side. Hence the application is closed as withdrawn.

Parties are directed to bear their own costs.
