2. We have heard applicants' counsel Shri Aggarwal and respondents' counsel Shri Arif.

3. Shri Aggarwal states at the Bar that although the relief paragraph contained other reliefs also, the only relief pressed by him is the one referred to in Para 1 above.

4. In this connection he states that applicants have become eligible for promotion but respondents have not convened the DPC to consider their case for promotion as Cameraman Grade III.

5. We dispose of this O.A. with a direction to respondents to hold the DPC within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with rules and instructions, and consider applicants' cases for promotion to the grade of Cameraman Grade III, if they fulfil the eligibility and other qualifications for being so promoted. No costs.
