
O R D E R (ORAL)

The controversy in this case arises in a narrow compass. It is an admitted fact, that the applicant was engaged by the respondents as outsider Postman w.e.f. 1.6.94 on daily wages and continued upto 20.4.96. The applicant has failed to show as to how the scheme dated 12.4.1991 formulated by the respondents regarding grant of temporary status and regularisation in respect of Group 'D' employees applies to him as, admittedly he was working in Group 'C' post. Therefore, his claim for temporary status and other benefits under this scheme would not be applicable. The respondents have submitted that the applicant has continued to be engaged as substitute/outsider Postman against absentee/Leave vacancy and not against any regular vacancy as the nature of their duties to deliver mail is a continuing process.

2. For the reasons given above, the reliefs claimed by the applicant in this OA are rejected as they do not fall within the provisions of the scheme formulated by the respon-

dants on which he relies. However, since the respondents have themselves stated that he has been engaged whenever need arose against absence of the regular employee on leave, etc., they shall continue to engage him whenever such need arises in preference to ~~the~~ other outsiders and freshers, as outsider Postman.

3. With these observations, this OA is disposed of.
