Heard learned counsel on either side.

Petitioners apprehend that their services might be terminated.

Shri P.H. Ramchandani, learned counsel for the respondents states that the applicants are continuing in service and, therefore, the apprehension expressed in clause (b) of para 8 of the relief is without any foundation. Their second prayer is for grant of temporary status and regularisation on the basis of Casual Labour Scheme. Shri Ramchandani submits that the applicants have not completed the minimum

number of days for consideration of temporary status and as soon as they complete, the respondents are preped to consider their case. There is a submission in the petition that the applicants have completed 206 days. On facts, Shri Rāmchandani, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the applicants have completed two spells of 180 days each in two different years.

2. This petition ^{is} ~~can be~~ disposed of by a ~~suitable~~ direction to the respondents to consider the eligibility of the applicants for temporary status and pass an order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order in accordance with the Scheme. Till such time, the applicants' services shall not be dispensed with.
