2. It is not denied that three applicants  
in the present OA are identically placed as the

beneficiary of the CAT Jabalpur Bench order dated 13.05.99 in OA-562/90 (Suresh Kumar D. Vs. UOI & Ors).

3. It is also not denied that applicants in the present OA are senior to Sh. Suresh Kumar D. in the feeder grade of Head Clerk/Accountant.

4. Under the circumstances, the OA is disposed of with a direction to respondents to extend the benefits of the Jabalpur Bench order dated 13.05.99 in Suresh Kumar D's case (supra) to the present applicants also, after Sh. Suresh Kumar D. <sup>has</sup> <sup>been</sup> <sup>reasonable</sup> ~~also~~ given an opportunity of being heard in the matter.

5. These directions should be implemented within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
