The petitioner has sought review of the order dated 13.12.1993 by which theoriginal application No. 2482/93 was dismissed at the admission stage itself as not making a prima facie case for admission under Section 19(3) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985. The in the O.A. relief claimed by the applicant is for declaration of the Assessment Board constituted of the U.P.S.C. as Member the without Null and void as well as quash the selection and appointment of meteorologist Grade I made on the recommendation of the Assessment Board dated 18.5.1993 with a flurther direction to the respondents to re-constitute the Assessment Board for selection of eligible meteorologist Grade I and to consider the promotion of the applicant and to give effect to the same from the date the juniors are promoted with all consequential benefits.

In the elaborate order under review the matter has been fully discussed with the applicant has been duly considered and after his consideration he has no right to challenge the constitution of the Assessment Board. There is no error apparent on the face of the record to justify and interference on the grounds averred by the review applicant.

A review of a judgement is a serious atep.

Review can only be done where there is a glaring omission on patent mistake or grave error has

A mere repetition of old and new over rulled arguments is obviously insufficient. We are fortified in our view by the authority of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Chander Kanta Vs. Sheikh Habib reported in AIR 1975 SC P 1500 and in the case of A.T. Sharma Vs. A.P. Sharma and ors. reported in AIR 1979 SC P.1407. The Review Application, therefore, is dismissed by circulation.
