This review application has been filed by Sh. Surya Narain Tiwari against the order of this Tribunal dated 13.12.1993. This Tribunal had held that the applicant has failed to establish that he was appointed as typist/stenographer paid out of contingency and has to wait for his turn for taking advantage of promotions to Group-C post for which 10% of the vacancies are ear-marked.

No new evidence in this regard has been presented in the review application and the applicant

has reiterated the arguments which were advanced during the hearing of the case. He has also challenged our interpretation of the chart of duties of the Lower Division Clerk.

We do not find an error apparent on the face of record. The Review Application is rejected.
