ORDER (ORAL)

At the very outset, Shri Vishnu Bhat, learned counsel representing the respondents while referring to an order dated 18.11.2020 issued by the respondents, stated that since the order dated 10.12.2019 passed by this Tribunal in OAs.No.1559-1564/2018 has already been complied with, therefore, nothing survives in the present contempt petition. A copy of the order dated 18.11.2020 as produced by Shri Vishnu Bhat during the course of hearing, is ordered to be taken on record.

2. Shri P.Kamalesan, learned counsel representing the petitioners does not dispute the fact with regard to issuance of order dated 18.11.2020 by the respondents. He, however, states that the petitioners herein do not get the

complete benefits in terms of order dated 10.12.2019 passed by this Tribunal in OAs.No.1559-1564/2018, and, therefore, they may be given liberty to challenge the order dated 18.11.2020 by way of filing a fresh OA.

3. In view of the above, the Contempt Petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to challenge the order dated 18.11.2020 by way of filing a fresh OA in case they still remain dissatisfied with the said order.

4. Rule of the Court is discharged.
