ORDER (ORAL)**PER: SURESH KUMAR MONGA, MEMBER (J)**

The applicant's father had expired on 23.08.2019 while in the services of the respondents. He while claiming himself as a dependent upon his father submitted a representation on 06.09.2019 before the respondents seeking employment on compassionate grounds. The said representation was followed by one more representation dated 02.01.2020. The grievance of the applicant is that a period of more than one year has elapsed but uptil today no action has been taken by the respondents.

2. Shri P. Kamalesan, learned counsel representing the applicant, submitted that the applicant will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to decide his pending representations within a timeframe.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid limited prayer made by Shri P. Kamalesan, learned counsel for the applicant, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present Original Application at the admission stage itself without entering into the merits of the case.

4. Accordingly, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to the Chief Post Master General, Karnataka Circle, Bangalore to decide the applicant's pending representations dated 06.09.2019 and 02.01.2020 and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law. The applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing before taking such a

decision. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. Ordered accordingly. No order as to costs.
