ORDER (Oral)


Learned counsel heard.

2. Applicant's mother late Smt. Shakuntala Kumari is stated to have died in harness on 27.7.1996. Petitioner had made an application for appointment on compassionate ground. It is stated that when even on attaining majority in the year 2000, he was not being appointed on compassionate ground, he had approached the Railway Board in this connection. The Railway Board vide Annexure A-1 dated 11.9.2003 had

recommended to the General Manager (P), Northern Railway, New Delhi that in view of the "poor financial condition of the family" applicant may be appointed on compassionate ground in Allahabad Division as a special case. It is alleged that respondents have yet not provided the applicant appointment in Group-C service in terms of Annexure A-1 dated 11.9.2003.

3. Having regard to the contentions raised before me, in my view this OA can be disposed of at this stage itself even without putting the respondents on notice to treat the present OA as a representation of the applicant and to take a decision in the matter of pending request of the applicant for appointment on compassionate ground by passing a detailed and speaking order within a period of three months from the date of communication of these orders. Ordered accordingly.
