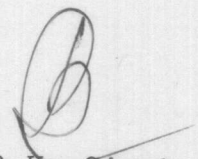
Heard the learned counsels, Shri R.V. Sinha for the applicant and Shri D.N. Goburdhan for respondent No.1 and 2 regarding appointment of the applicant on compassionate ground, and Shri P.P. Khurana for respondent No.3 regarding vacation of the quarter occupied by the widow and son of the deceased employee, Shri S.G. Hasan. Shri Hasan died in harness in 1991. He was working as Librarian with the respondents at the time of his death. He was posted at Government Boys Sr. Secondary School No.2, Dakshinpuri, New Delhi. He had been allotted quarter No. B-21/2, Sector-I, Pushpa Vihar, M.B. Road, New Delhi as per his entitlement.

2. The learned counsel for respondent No.1 and 2 made a statement at the bar that they will consider the appointment of the applicant on compassionate ground against class III post provided he clears the typing test in Hindi and English. The learned counsel

for the applicant has no objection to this. The respondents will communicate the date <sup>and time</sup> of typing test to be held to the applicant. The applicant is directed to appear at the test. If he passes in the Hindi/English typing test, he will be eligible for appointment to a class III post failing which he may be accommodated against any suitable vacancy in class-IV. On receipt of the appointment letter he will vacate the quarter No. B-21/2 Sector-I, Pushpa Vihar, M.B. Road, New Delhi. Till then they will remain in the said quarter on payment of normal rent.

With these observations the application is disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.
