O R D E R (ORAL)

BY HON. MR. JUSTICE S.R. SINGH, V.C.


Heard Sri K.C. Sinha, learned counsel for applicant and Sri V.V. Mishra holding brief of Sri R.C. Joshi, learned counsel for respondents. We have also perused the pleadings.

2. The applicants, who are working on the post of Survey Assistants, have instituted this O.A. seeking a direction to the respondents to allocate the separate quota for each feeder cadre in relation to the post of Officer Surveyor Group 'B'. It is not disputed that appointment to the post of Officer Surveyor Group 'B' is made by promotion from different feeder cadres including Survey Assistants. The applicants, it is stated at the bar by Sri K.C. Sinha, have preferred representation to the 1st respondent for redressal of their grievances raised in this O.A. Since it is basically for the rule making authority/executive to prescribe quota, if any, for promotion to a post appointment to which is made from different feeder cadres, *it would be but proper if the competent authority be called upon to decide the representation.*

3. We are, therefore, of the view that it would <sup>meet</sup> ~~make~~ the ends of justice if the present O.A. is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the applicants file representation, the Secretary, Ministry of Science and Technology, New Delhi shall consider and dispose it of in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the representation along with copy of this order.
