By this application u/s 19 of A.T.Act the applicant has challenged the order of transfer dated 3.9.1997 by which he had been transferred from Lucknow Division to Samastipur Division on administrative grounds. From the order it appears that a post of Travelling Ticket Examiner (TTE) in the grade of 1400-2300 was transferred on temporary basis for a period of six months from Lucknow Division to Samastipur Division and On this transferred post applicant was transferred. There is nothing on record that this order was further extended beyond the period of six months. The transfer order was passed three years before. Thus there remains nothing to be decided in

this application as the impugned order of transfer ^{is} only for a period of six months, for which the post was transferred. If the respondents ^{are} ~~is~~ still keen to transfer the applicant from Lucknow Division to Samastipur Division they will have to pass a fresh order in accordance with law.
