




2. Perused the pleadings on record particularly pleadings contained in O.A. Sri Satish Mandhyan, Advocate on behalf of respondents points out that dispute in the present O.A. relates to promotion, which relates to the year 1998. Now 10 years have elapsed. One can imagine, various officers have been retired and factual scene has been changed drastically. We also find that annexure A-1 to the O.A. is not legible;



reference may be made to para-12 to 16 of said annexure. Learned counsel for the applicant is not present to press this O.A. It appears that applicant is not interested in prosecuting the matter since the same has become stale. O.A. is accordingly dismissed. However, it is made clear that dismissal of this O.A. shall not prejudice the right of applicant for making his claim of promotion, if any, under law.
