

ORDER

Hon'ble Mr. S. Dayal, Member (A) :-

This Contempt Petition has been filed for alleged deliberate disobedience of order dated 21-12-2000, directing the respondents to reinstate the applicant on the post. The applicant was declared not entitled to back wages and the respondents had been given freedom to pass fresh orders in accordance with law. The respondents have filed their counter reply in which they have stated that the orders for reinstating the applicant had been passed on 10-10-2001 and the applicant has assumed his duties on 18-10-2001.


