
ORDER (O\_r\_a\_l)



The applicant has come up seeking the relief to the effect that he be promoted to the post of Dresser w.e.f. 24-8-1996 and and be granted the pay scale of Rs.4000-6000 from that date. The applicant moved a representation to the competent authority respondent no.4 which has been turned down vide order dated

10-11-2000, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure-6 to the OA by a well detailed reasoned order and no good ground has been shown to set aside the same. Moreover, under the relief clause there is no prayer to quash this order dated 10-11-2000. Under the circumstances the relief sought for cannot be granted. The OA is dismissed in limine.
