communication of the order. The direction was to appoint





2. It appears that the Writ Petition was filed against the said order by respondent no. 4. The said Writ Petition was dismissed on 12.3.2004. However, Union of India, it is stated by the learned counsel for the applicant, also preferred a Writ Petition, which is still pending and since no interim order was passed, the respondents issued appointment order in favour of present applicant vide order dated 13.09.2004 and the applicant has joined his duties on the same date. In the circumstances we find no case is made out to proceed further in the contempt petition.

3. Accordingly, the contempt application is dismissed. Notices issued are discharged.
