



**ORDER**

The applicant appeared in the examination for promotion to the cadre of postman and having been qualified the same he got promotion in such capacity i.e. Post Man w.e.f. 21.06.1975.

2. In terms of TBOP skill, Postmen were entitled to benefit of first Time Bound Promotion on completion on 16 years of service and second TBOP on completion of 26 years of service. In the present case, the applicant completed 16 years of service as postman on 21.06.1991. Accordingly, he was granted the benefit of first upgradation in terms of aforementioned scheme, he was granted pay scale of Rs. 950-1450/- w.e.f. 21.06.1991. He could have become entitled to second PBOP (Time Bound promotion) only on 21.06.2001, however, before that he retired on 31.12.2000, thus could not be given such benefit.

3. In view of afore mentioned, I do not find any infirmity in the impugned order dated 16.10.2003, accordingly, declined to interfere with the same O.A. dismissed. No order as to costs.
