ORDER (ORAL)**PER: SURESH KUMAR MONGA, MEMBER (J)**

The present Original Application has been filed by the applicant under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 seeking therein a direction to the respondents to grant him grade pay of Rs.5400/- from the date of eligibility in accordance with the Government of India, Resolution No. GIMF No.1/1/2008-1C dated 29.08.2008.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the applicant submitted that before filing the present Original Application, the applicant submitted a representation dated 08.01.2020 which was followed by another representation dated 20.03.2021. However, the respondents have failed to take any decision over the said representations upto now. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to decide his pending representations while keeping in view the earlier orders passed by this Tribunal in Original Application No.850/2014, 859/2014 and 893/2014.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid limited prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present Original Application at the admission stage itself without entering into the merits of the case.

4. Accordingly, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to Chief Post Master General, Karnataka Circle, Bangalore (Respondent No.2 herein) to decide the applicant's pending representations dated 08.01.2020

and 20.03.2021 and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law. Before taking such a decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. However, there shall be no orders so as to costs.
