



after the list was revised. There is also no
request on behalf of the applicant. On the earlier
occasions also none appeared on behalf of the
applicant. On 17.8.1994, it was observed by the
court that the application is prima-facie time
barred since the cause of action arose on
2.5.1989. However, final decision on the case

was not taken on the request of the counsel for the applicant who undertook to satisfy the court on the point of limitation. Sufficient opportunities have already been granted to the applicant but he has not ~~not~~ ^{if} availed the same.
