O R D E R (ORAL)


BY JUSTICE R.R.K. TRIVEDI, V.C.

This application has been filed challenging the selection for the post of Assistant Personnel Officer Class II (APO in short) held on 12.2.1984 and 30.4.1984. It is not disputed that the applicant appeared in the written examination and viva voce test but he could not find place in the panel. He filed this O.A. challenging the aforesaid selection on 23.11.93 i.e. after about nine years. The applicant felt aggrieved only when another person was given officiating chance to serve as APO and on objection of the applicant

the concerned person was immediately reverted back to his original post and selected person was appointed. It is stated that the applicant had already retired from service in the year 1994. In the circumstances we do not find any good ground to interfere with the selection. The application is accordingly dismissed. No order as to costs.
