on his appointment as E.D. Runner &
Delivery Agent. Since a fresh appointment has been made to the post of E.D. Runner, the applicant therefore, has to make a way for appointment of Dhruva Raj to his original post.

2. The applicant has challenged the appointment of one Bankey Lal on the post of E.D. Runner on which Dhruva Raj was earlier temporarily appointed. We are of the view that the applicant has no locus standi in challenging the appointment of Bankey Lal to the post of E.D. Runner and if at all such appointment can be challenged ^{it is} only by Dhruva Raj and not by the applicant.

3. In view of the foregoing, we hold that this application is misconceived and the same is, therefore, dismissed in limine at the admission stage itself.
