


ORDER (ORAL)

We have heard Sri M.K. Upadhyay for applicant and Sri S.K. Om B/h for Km. S. Srivastava.

2. By this O.A. under section 19 of the AT Act, 1985 the applicant has challenged the order dated 16.11.1992 by which applicant was reverted from the post of Accountant to his original post of Postal Assistant. The order contains that the applicant was junior most. He was allowed officiating charge. It is not disputed that he was not selected on merits for promotion to the post of Accountant. Respondents have also followed the rules of last come first go. As the applicant happen to be the junior most, he has been reverted from the post of Accountant to his original post. In the circumstances we do not find any illegality in the order. O.A. is accordingly dismissed without
