



This contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order in O.A.No.1235 of 1995 dated 02.12.1999, by which the respondents were directed to appoint the applicant on the post for which recruitment test was held, grant them seniority from the date of appointment of their juniors without payment of any backwages. Suppl. counter-affidavit filed by learned counsel for the respondents shows that the applicants have been given appointment by order dated 04.01.2001 and counsel for the respondents states that the applicants have already joined in pursuance of the order. We have seen the orders of the appointment of the applicant and orders grant them seniority from the date on which their juniors have been appointed. We, thus, find that the order stands fully complied and dismiss-- the contempt petition and also discharged the notices issued to the opposite parties.
