This contempt application has been filed alleging disobedience of the order dated 1.11.99 passed in OA 591/97. By the above order this Tribunal has directed the respondents to decide the appeal of the applicant within a period of 6^{or 4} weeks. It is not disputed that the appeal has been decided. Learned counsel for the applicant, however, submitted that the order is cryptic and does not given reasons.

2. The illegality in passing order cannot be subject matter of the contempt application. We have only to see whether the order has been complied with^{or not}. If the applicant^{is} ~~does~~ not satisfied with the order, he may challenge the order in the O.A. Contempt application is accordingly dismissed. Notices issued are discharged.
