

This Contempt petition has been filed under Section 17 of the A.T. Act, 1985, for punishing the respondent for wilful disobedience of the order of this Tribunal dated 5.6.2002 passed in O.A. no. 650 of 2002.

2. Notice was issued to the respondent to appear in person vide order dated 10.7.2003. The respondent has appeared in person and tendered his apology for delaying in complying with the order of this Tribunal.
