

The case relates to granting of seniority w.e.f. 1978 because his juniors were regularised from that date. We find that the applicant was superannuated from his job on 31.08.1996 and filed his representation for the first time on 16.10.2001, i.e. several years after retirement. Counsel for the applicant also claims that he filed an application dated 13.07.97, which the counsel for the respondents points out that the same



has never been received by the department. There is no receipt of department at all on the letter (annexure A-4). Even if such a letter has been received, the claim was highly time barred. The cause of action arose some time in the year 1978 and for the first time he , according to his own admission, has filed an application in the year 1997. The case is highly time barred and not worth admission. The O.A. is rejected at admission stage. No costs.
