JUSTICE R.R.K.TRIVEDI,V.C.

By this OA applicant has prayed for a direction to antedate the promotion of the applicant w.e.f 1.8.1982 as Chief Yard Master Grade 2000-3200(RPS) and seniority with retrospective effect with all consequential benefits . In our opinion, the applicant is not entitled for the relief as the claim raised now through this OA filed on 15.5.2002, is grossly time barred. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant was making representations before the departmental authorities. However, the legal position is well settled that by



making successive representations period of limitation prescribed by law cannot be extended. The applicant was expected to wait for the decision of the administrative authorities for a reasonable time. He has approached this Tribunal after 20 years. The OA is grossly time barred and is rejected as such. No order as to costs.
