O R D E R

By Hon'ble Mr. Justice Khem Karan, V.C. :

It has been stated in ~~the~~^{his} reply that the applicant has already preferred a departmental appeal against the impugned order dated 13.9.2005 and the same is still pending before the authority concerned. The fact of ~~that~~ appeal is pending, has not been disputed by Shri Tripathi. In the circumstances, it is proper that this OA be disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Authority to consider and dispose of the departmental appeal within time to be fixed by this Tribunal and there is no point in keeping this OA pending here till then.
