2. Learned counsel for the applicant would contend that he has already preferred representation dated 31.05.2004 (Annexure-A-4) to the Competent Authority/ Post Master General, Bareilly Region,


Bareilly for considering his case for promotion to the post of Post man, but the respondents are not paying any heed to the request of the applicant. Learned counsel for the applicant would further contend that his grievance might be redressed, in case a direction is given to the competent authority to consider and decide the pending representation dated 31.05.2004 (Annexure-A-4) of the applicant by a reasoned and speaking order within a specified period of time.

2. Having heard Sri S. C. Mishra learned counsel for the respondents, we hereby direct the Respondents No. 1/ Post Master General, Bareilly Region, Bareilly, to consider and decide the pending representation dated 31.05.2004 (Annexure-A-4) of the applicant by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

3. With the above direction, the OA stands disposed of with no order as to costs.
