Mr. Kyada, the learned counsel for the respondents, states, "The petitioner Shri D.A. Gor was trade-tested on 13.5.1992 and was successful and is promoted on 27.8.1992. Out of the deleted applicants Nos. <sup>2 to 25</sup> ~~21 to 25~~, the applicants No. 9, 12, 17, 20 & 22 are kept on the list of stand-by candidates for being called for selection while the remaining out of the deleted applicants have been promoted pursuant to the result of that trade-test".

Mr. Kyada further states that, in view of the aforesaid development, the present O.A. is rendered infructuous and Mr. Pandit agrees with that. <sup>now</sup> O.A therefore, stands disposed of as being <sup>now</sup> infructuous. No cost.
