On consent of both the parties when the Original Application is taken up for hearing on admission, the petition for addition of parties being M.A.no.491/97 filed on 18.12.97, is taken up for hearing and disposed of.

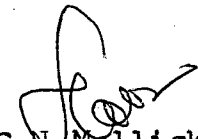
In the instant application, the petitioner wants to implead 18 persons as private respondents who are alleged to have been given appointment in the impugned posts. The ld.counsel appearing for the respondents, has no objection if the instant application is allowed. The Miscellaneous Application is allowed. Private respondents described in the aforesaid application be added as private respondent nos.7 onwards. The cause title of the application(OA) be amended accordingly by the Registry and appropriate notes be kept in the Register. It further appears that the petitioner has already served copy of the amendment application along with a copy of the Original Application. The

Postal Registration Slips have been filed which may be kept with the records and we are satisfied that the service is complete so far as the private respondents are concerned.

The Original Application is admitted for adjudication. It is submitted by the ld.counsel appearing for the respondents that the short reply which he has filed , does not contain sufficient details to meet the allegations made in the application and as such , he prays to file a detailed reply.

Considering the age of the application and the urgency of the matter, the application is listed for hearing on 7.4.98. Reply if any, to be put in within 3 weeks before the next date and rejoinder, if any, within 2 weeks thereafter.
