Counsel for the respondents by placing copy of the service book of the applicants submits that the applicants have since been promoted as Head Clerk in the scale of Rs.5000 – 8000/- w.e.f. 3.6.2000 and the said promotion having become effective and the grievance of the applicants having been made substantially, the application has become infructuous.
