The Original Application is taken up for hearing as per
the order in MA No.724/03.

2. The prayers in the OA are for a declaration that the
applicant is entitled to be considered for regular appointment
(on compassionate basis) to the post of E.D.D.A.(Gramin Dak Sevak
Mail Deliverer), Ayirakuzhy, which the applicant is holding after
the death of his father and for a direction to the respondents
accordingly.

3. The respondents resist the application by filing a reply statement to which the applicant has filed a rejoinder. However, it has been stated in the MA No.724/03 that the applicant has been appointed as Gramin Dak Sevak Mail Deliverer, Ayirakuzhy P.O. with effect from 1.7.2002 on compassionate ground. Since the applicant has already been appointed as Gramin Dak Sevak Mail Deliverer with effect from 1.7.2002, the respondents themselves have granted to the applicant the reliefs sought in the application.

4. Therefore, taking note of the statement made in the MA that the applicant has been appointed as a Gramin Dak Sevak Mail Deliverer on compassionate ground with effect from 1.7.02, the application is closed without any further direction. No costs.
