Applicant seeks a direction to respondents to
appoint him as an Extra Departmental Delivery Agent.
He has been working in the post for some time, but his
candidature has not been sponsored by the Employment
Exchange. Sponsorship by the Employment Exchange is
an essential pre-requisite for consideration in the



light of the decision in Ranganayakulu's case (1995) 30 ATC 473. Whether in the case of employees who have officiated for long in a post, sponsorship should be dispensed with is a matter for the Government to consider. We would only direct first respondent to consider A2 representation. This will be done before a regular appointment is made. We have not expressed any opinion on the merits.

2 Standing counsel submits that he will forward a copy of the original application and a copy of this order to first respondent for compliance. We record the submission.

3 Original application is disposed of as aforesaid. No costs.
