The application having been heard on 3rd April, 1997,
the Tribunal on the same day delivered the following:

O R D E R

HON'BLE SHRI AV HARIDASAN, VICE CHAIRMAN

Applicant, who had rendered service as a substitute Extra Departmental Agent on various Extra Departmental posts for a considerable length of time, made a representation to the Superintendent of Post Offices, Tiruvalla, requesting that he may be regularly appointed to any one of the Extra Departmental posts pointing out that he heard that one or more vacancies are likely to arise in the near future. Recruitment to Extra Departmental

posts is in accordance with the instructions issued in this regard by the Director General, Posts & Telegraph. There is no extant instruction for absorption of a substitute Extra Departmental Agent. When a vacancy arises in a particular post, the applicant would also be entitled to put forth his candidature and if that is done, the selecting authority may consider applicant's case also. Applicant has no right to claim a regular appointment and absorption as prayed for in this application.

2. The application, therefore, does not merit admission. Hence, it is rejected under Section 19 (3) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.
