Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.


The applicants are aggrieved by the fact that they have
been regularised in the post of U.D.C. with effect from
October 1988, whereas, according to them, they should have
been regularised from June 1985, since ^{when} ~~then~~ they have been
officiating as U.D.C. on ad hoc basis. The learned counsel
conceded that the applicants have been drawing the regular

pay scale of U.D.C. ever since June 1985 and for that period drawn increments also. The applicants' apprehension is that in the matter of seniority in the grade of U.D.C., their previous service as U.D.C. between June 1985 and October, 1988 will not be taken into account and they will suffer for further promotions. The applicants are apprehending certain action on the part of the respondents on the basis of conjectures and speculation. The learned counsel for the applicants state that the applicants' seniority in the grade of U.D.C. has not yet been finalised.

2. In the circumstances, we do not see any justification in entertaining this application at this premature stage. The application is thus closed as premature with liberty to the applicants to approach this Tribunal, if so advised in accordance with law, in case they feel aggrieved by reckoning or non-reckoning of their service as U.D.C. for the purpose of seniority.
