ORDER


CHETTUR SANKARAN NAIR(J), VICE CHAIRMAN

Applicant seeks to quash A1 order rejecting his request for a "permanent transfer" to Kottayam. Respondent Chief General Manager examined the facts of the case and rejected the request for transfer. Learned Counsel for applicant would submit that respondents are guilty of discrimination. Question of discrimination arises only in the context of rights, and in the matter of transfer no employee belonging to a transferable service, has any manner of right to remain

at any place or at any place for any length of time. Authority is legion for this proposition and if any is needed, it is found in Gujarat Electricity Board & anr Vs. Atmaram Sungomal Poshani (AIR 1989 SC 1433), Union of India & Ors Vs. SL Abbas (AIR 1993 SC 2444), NK Singh Vs. Union of India & Ors (AIR 1995 SC 423) and Chief General Manager Vs. Rajendra CH. Bhattacharjee (1995 (2) SCC 532). It was then argued that others have been given certain concessions and applicant must also be given the same concession. There is no such right as pointed out by the Supreme Court in Chandigarh Administration & Anr Vs. Jagjit Singh & Anr. (AIR 1995 SC 705).

2. The application is without merit and we dismiss the same. No costs.
