O R D E R

CHETTUR SANKARAN NAIR (J), VICE CHAIRMAN

Pursuant to the directions in OA 1916/93, second respondent was to make a fresh selection for the post of Extra Departmental Branch Postmaster, Nanniode Post Office.

2. Applicant challenges the selection made pursuant to this direction. According to him, the selection should have been made on the basis of the rules in force at the time when the vacancy arose on 18.2.1993. He relies on the decision in P. Mahendran vs. State of Karnataka (AIR 1990 SC 405) to support his contention.

3. We find that applicant has filed Annexure A4 representation and that the same is pending consideration before the second



respondent. We direct second respondent to consider the representation with notice to the person, if any, selected and pass final orders.


4. Status quo as of today will be maintained till a decision is taken as aforesaid by the second respondent.
