O R D E R


When the O.A. was taken up for admission, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that it is suffice to direct the third respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on A-1 representation within a time frame and also to direct the third respondent to fill up the vacancy of Supervisor/Postal Assistant(SBCO) only in accordance with the approved norms.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the departmental respondents submitted that there is no objection in adopting such a course.

3. Accordingly the third respondent is directed to consider A-1 representation dated 18.2.98 submitted by the applicant and pass appropriate orders within six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Respondents are further directed not to fill up the existing vacancy of Supervisor/Postal Assistant(SBCO) Central Region against the norms now in force.

4. The O.A. is disposed of as above. No costs.
