Applicant seeks a declaration that he is eligible
to be appointed as Library and Information Assistant in the
scale 1400-2600 after upgradation of the post of Lower
Division Clerk in the library. He has made a representation
A4 voicing his grievances and he apprehends that
someone else may be appointed before the representation
is considered. That should not happen. A4 is a
representation addressed to two authorities at the same
time and as in the nature of things, a corporate decision
cannot be taken. Applicant will make up his mind as to
who he should move and he may move that authority within
seven days from today forwarding a copy of the representation

to the Senior Central Government Standing Counsel. Senior Central Government Standing Counsel will ensure that the representation is considered on its merits and a speaking order passed before any appointment is made to the post in question.
