
The applicant who sought appointment to the post of

seeking a declaration that she is entitled to be considered and
appointed against the OBC reservation quota.

2. Today when the matter came up before the Bench, the
learned counsel appearing for the applicant produced a copy of
the order No.BB/2.II/Dlg. dated 12.2.99 and submitted that the
applicant's name appear in the list of candidates selected


